PLEASE NOTE THERE ARE VARIOUS UNIVERSITIES IN MADRID. THE CONFERENCE IS THE <u>UNED UNIVERSITY</u> AND NOT THE COMPLUTENSE UNIVERSITY OF MADRID. ALTHOUGH ALL FACULTIES ARE IN THE SAME *CAMPUS UNIVERSITARIO* AREA.

#### TRANSPORT TO THE CONFERENCE VENUE

The Faculties of Psychology and Education (UNED) Universidad Nacional de Educación a Distancia, where the main PLL5 Conference will take place are on the outskirts of the North-east of Madrid in the general University Campus (Ciudad Universitaria) area. Transport will be required to get to the Conference venue as there are no accommodation options in Ciudad Universitaria beyond student accommodation (see our info on accommodation in madrid on www.iapll.com)

The areas nearest the Conference venue for accommodation and transport are in the general ara known as CHAMBERÍ:

PLAZA DE ESPAÑA (Plaza de España is nearest the centre of the city, although all the other above areas are very well connected by bus and metro to the centre. The buses that we recommend below leave from Plaza de España and go through Argüelles and Moncloa.

## BY BUS

## From Plaza de España:

Option 1: BUS 133 (going towards Mirasierra): 22 minutes aprox.

Directions: Bus stop Gran Vía - Plaza de España to bus stop Madrid Puerta de Hierro 5600 (about 15 minutes) + 350 m. walk to Juan del Rosal Street.

Below you have the 11 stops of bus 133 from Plaza de España to Puerta de Hierro 5600.



Option 2: BUS 44 (Marqués de Viana) + BUS 624A (Acanto-Tomillaron): 25 minutes aprox.

Directions: Bus stop Gran Vía - Plaza de España take bus 44 to bus stop Moncloa (about 9 minutes) + 3 minutes walk to the main transport hub in Moncloa called *Intercambiador de Moncloa*.

There you then take bus 624A to bus stop <u>Madrid Puerta de Hierro 5600</u> (about 1 minute) + and then walk approx 350 m to the Conference venue.

# BY METRO

## From Plaza de España:

Take Metro line in Plaza de España to Moncloa (about 3 minutes, 3 stops). Then, you can take one of these buses:

- Bus 624A (Acanto-Tomillaron) to bus stop Madrid Puerta de Hierro 5600 (about 1 minute) + 350 m. walking.
- Bus 621 (Avda. de España Urb. Las Cañadas II) to bus stop Madrid Puerta de Hierro 5600 (about 2 minutes) + 350 m. walking.

Also, from Moncloa you can take Metro line to Ciudad Universitaria (about 7 minutes). From there you will have a 13 minute wlk to the Conference venue (1 km).

#### **HOW DO I PAY ON TRANSPORT IN MADRID?**

Bear in mind that you can pay for a bus trip with any internationally recognised credit card. credit card. However, the Multicard option below is much more efficient especially if you are visiting for a few days.

## 1.2 Single & 10 Trips Tickets

If you happen to be visiting Madrid for only a few days or weeks, or if you don't need to use the public transport system on a daily basis, you can use Madrid's more **short-term option known** as **the Multi Card**. As with the personal public transport card, you will **first need to purchase the card** itself (only **2.5€**), then you **top up the short-term pass** of your choice onto the card. The Multi Card offers two options: **Single tickets** and **10 trip tickets**.

Single & 10 trips tickets - Prices & Where to Buy



A single journey on public transport in Madrid will usually cost between 1,50€ and 2€, making it very budget friendly. If you don't want to top up your card every time you need it, you should consider buying a 10 trip ticket which costs just 12,20€. Both tickets work on metro and bus systems within zone A. As the Multi Card is not personalized, it can be shared with others.

Buying the Multi Card and it's corresponding tickets is incredibly easy. All you need to do is go to any metro station in Madrid and place your order at any of the ticket machines there. These machines look like ATMs but will have the branding of the Madrid metro on them. Once there you can pay either in cash or with credit card.

Please be aware that you may change freely between various metro lines once you are inside the metro system. But changing from metro to bus or from one bus to another means that you have to use your card again. That being said, you can also top up your Multi Card from the bus driver – but only in cash.

# **TAXIS**

**Taxis in Madrid.** Taxis are a very common form of transport and relatively economical, especially if you share. A taxi from Moncloa to the Conference venue should costs approx €10-€13


